

**AEG Inland Empire Chapter, Southern California Section  
Meetings Summary To-Date (Aug-Nov-2005 Meetings Minutes)**

Meeting in early August jointly with the Inland Geological Society in Riverside, CA were a large audience for two speakers "Monitoring Slope Deformation with Quadrilaterals for Pipeline Risk Management" by Jeff Keaton, **MACTEC**, followed by a longer talk "Bluebird Canyon Landslides: Past, Present, and Future" by Woody Higdon, **Geo-Tech Imagery**.

In September we met in Temecula cancelling the meeting when only 3 persons showed (few that didn't show where at the AEG Annual Meeting and Symposium in Las Vegas). We met jointly with the Inland Geological Society in Riverside in October where AEG Member Jason Preece, **ENGEO Inc.**, and President of the **California Consortium of Geoscience Organizations (CCGO)** spoke about "Update on California Professional Practice Issues and the Professional Geologist in California; Insight on the type and quantity of professional work Geologists do", an extremely interesting and important message for all attendees, registered or not.

The November meeting in Temecula, due to lack of turn-out at the previous Temecula meeting, was re-scheduled in San Bernardino for an Election Meeting. However, a Special Temecula Meeting was actually held with 23 attendees a week before the San Bernardino meeting. On 16-Nov-05 the Chapter's Election meeting occurred in San Bernardino with 13 attendees. Southern California Section Chairman Charles Nestle, **L.A. County Dept. Public Works**, attended and spoke at both November meetings. Jeff Keaton, **MACTEC**, presented the Official Certificate recognizing the AEG Inland Empire Chapter, presented at the National Meeting, and signed by AEG President David W.
