
SAN DIEGO NATIONAL METTING

LEGISLATION UPDATE

AB 940 (Public members on Registration Committees Boards) is being read on the floor of the Senate. The bill has been amended and portions of the bill dealing with registration fees has been eliminated. However, the Registration Board has adopted a new fee schedule for geologists, engineering geologists and geophysicists which may be added to AB 940 during Senate hearings.

AB 2175 (adds words "Negligence" to the Registration Act) has been sent to the Senate Rules Committee for hearings.
